

# Twin Cheer Bow With Or Without Tails

Use two different colors of their School. You will need 1 strip of 9" ribbon in one color and 1 strip of 9" ribbon in another color for the bow itself. Plus 6" for the bows center. If you would like tails pick a color out of the two that you would like to use most and measure and cut 12" or so, depending on how long your child's school name or her name is.





Take each color ribbon and make a loop, sew a few stitches to hold the loop together or glue it if your wish. I like sewing it better.



Tie your loops into a bow by using wire or elastic. I'm using a ribbon so you can get a better feel for what should be done.



Now place one bow on top of the other criss cross style.



Make a center for your bow. You can make a rosette center by tying a knot in the center of the 6" ribbon or you can just fold it over and glue it. If her school has a team pin you can glue that to the center!



Tails or no tails? If you want tails cut your ribbon on an angle on both ends. Fold the ribbon in half and spread it out a bit. Glue it to the back of the bow. Now you can embroider her name or her schools name or you can use a paint pen or just leave it plain.
