

CuRLz and PeaRLz FunKY BoW!

Materials needed:

Wire - 18-20 gauge

Clippie of your choice, French clippie is preferred for the stability of the bow

Spray fabric stiffener

Needle and thread

White tissue paper or Paper towels

You can change any of the above colors and patterns to anything that you wish, have fun with this! I am just letting you know what was specific colored/patterend ribbons were used on this exact bow because we have gotten many request from costumers that want to learn how to make the exact bows the way they were shown in the picture! This is for you girls. :)

1.5" neon green ribbon 2 pieces 7" long each with one end of the ribbon cut on an angle like V shape.

1.5" yellow grosgrain ribbon 42" long 7/8"

7/8" pink grosgrain ribbon 25" long

Prepare your korker ribbons

Cut 10 korkers 1" each

Cut 10 Korkers 1 and 1/2" each

And 10 2" each

The 3 sets of korkers must be different in some way ie, 1" korkers can be purple, 1 and 1/2 can be pink, 2" korkers could be white. You need to do it this way so that you will have a flower effect to them. This is a baby version of my pearl double and triple decker bows because we want this to be a beautiful center piece for our Curlz and Pearlz Bow. You can alter

the sizes of the korkers for anything else.

Fray check all of them before you make this bow



Use a nice long piece of wire. What you are going to be doing is threading your korkers onto this piece of wire. You can also use a need and thread if you like! One by one thread your 2" korkers onto the wire, in between that put a strand of your pearls and take your wire wrap it around the strand, continue on threading your korkers. As you are threading your korkers move them around so that they are in a spread out position don't just stack them on top of one another. Remember a korker bow is supposed to be round.



After your are done with your 2" korkers, do the same thing with your 1 and 1/2" korkers, don't forget to put in some pear strands and wrap the wire around the strand to keep it in place.

DO not mix up your different sized korkers or you will not have the flower

effect showing.



When done take your wire and wrap it around your korker a couple of times to keep it secure. Now fluff up your ribbons to cover your wire or thread and so that your pretty pearls will show. Put this aside for now.



1.5" yellow grosgrain ribbon 42" long, make a nice big 5" loop



Bring your ribbon back towards you and make another big 5" loop.



Repeat this again until you have 4 big nice loops! Clinch it in the center and wrap your wire around it well.





Take one of your tails and place it downward so you have two tails going down.





1.5" neon green ribbon 2 pieces 7" long each with one end of the ribbon cut on an angle like V shape, wire them together at the tips of the ribbons. Wire them to the back of your bow.

Make a 6 looped bow with your 7/8" pink ribbon. The same looped bow that you have been making all this time. Make 3" loops, wire that on top of your yellow bow. Measure and cut 7/8" pink ribbon 7-8" long. Place that on top of your 6 looped bow and secure it well with your wire. You can also add a 9" piece of 7/8" pink ribbon on before you add on your korker bow.

Now for the pretty part! Take that beautiful pearl triple decker korker that you made and wire that in the center of the bow.

This is defiantly a bow that you need to poof up your loops with your tissue paper, spray with your stiffener and let it dry. Remove your tissue paper and there you have your gorgeous CuRLz and PeaRLz BoW! YaY YOU!! =)
