

Chenille Headband and Scrunchies

You will need elastic, chenille, needle and thread. Measure your babies head and add 7" to it or so if you want it more rufflier. Cut your fabric 2" x____ and turn your chenille design side down. A sewing machine would go much faster but you can also do this in minutes with the plain "running" stitch. Over and under, over and under. Fold your fabric in half width wise with the design side in. Sew all the way down the line. Turn inside out. Cut your elastic and add a safety pin on one end of the elastic. You will need this there so that it will be easier for you to pull you elastic through your chenille. When you have it all the way through sew your elastic pieces together or tie it in a knot, the choice is yours. Then you want to sew the end pieces together so you have one circle of fabric. If you want to

add a bow to this just cut a piece of fabric 4" x 3" sandwich together and sew the ends. You might want to use a little piece of fabric for the center so that it will look pretty. Or you might like to put some embellishment there instead.

A Scrunchie is the same way, without the bow and before you sew the pieces together twist the fabric around. Also use a longer piece of fabric.
