

Star Burst Bow

This is another *oldie but a goodie by Offray* bow that has been around since forever. A classic that is so versatile and beautiful that is a must for you to learn how make! It leaves so much room for you to show your own creative style!



Form a loop about 2 1/2" long, pinch between thumb and index finger



Bring ribbon down and up to form a bottom 2 1/2" loop. Repeat to form second set of loops. Cut off excess ribbon and wire center tightly.





Cut two 7" lengths and one 2 1/2" length. Gather your 7" lengths at centers and wire one ribbon to either side of bow.



Optional wrap your 2 1/2" ribbon around the center and glue it in place. OR you can add a nice embellishment instead, like a flower or a button, there is plenty of room here with this

bow for you to get creative! See some pictures below.



This is the Star Burst Bow made in grosgrain ribbon.



I wanted to show you this combo to give you some ideas on how to mix mediums. That's why I made the bow in both organza and in grosgrain. You can stack these bows on top of another in the opposite directions and get a beautiful look! Yes, you can stack grosgrain also on top of grosgrain AND you can stack more then two bows on top of each other! I have stacked 3 on top of eachother and it has

looked just lovely! Just don't forget to stack each one of top of each other in the opposite directions so you can be sure to show the beauty of each bow and it's tails!



Here it is with 2 bows stacked on top of each other and a beautiful Wedding flower quality purple rose in the center. These can even be made into PEW BOWS for Weddings if you want to get into niche. All you need to do is increase your measurements on your bows, i.e.: 7" and 14", double up you Star Burst bows and add something lovely in the center, like a satin Dove embellishment or flower. Live flowers can also be placed in the center if you

have them placed in a little water vial.
